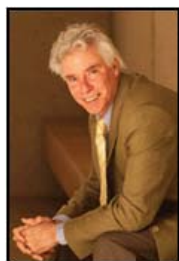

G. Reid Lyon, Ph.D. is a distinguished professor of the department of Education Policy and Leadership at Southern Methodist University. He holds a joint appointment in the school of Brain and Behavior Sciences at the University of Texas-Dallas where he is a distinguished scientist at the Center for Brain Health. Dr. Lyon served as a research psychologist and the Chief of the Child Development and Behavior Branch within the National Institute of Child Health and Human Development (NICHD) at the National Institutes of Health (NIH). Dr. Lyon has worked closely with the White House, the U.S. Department of Education, and Congress. He served as an advisor on education research and policies to President George W. Bush and First Lady Laura Bush. His work continues to ensure that scientific research occupies a central role in educational practices and policy.



Milton Dehn, Ed.D., NCSP, is a nationally recognized expert on processing assessment, working memory, and children's long-term memory problems. Dr. Dehn is the author of *Working Memory and Academic Learning*, *Helping Children Remember*, and *Long-Term Memory Problems in Children and Adolescents*. After working as a school psychologist and training school psychology graduate students for many years, Dr. Dehn is now a private practice school psychologist and the program director for Schoolhouse Tutoring, an agency in La Crosse, WI that provides assessment, consultation, and tutoring for children with learning and memory problems.



Cynthia Buechler is a partner with the Austin law firm of Buechler & Associates, P.C. Ms. Buechler served as a Hearing Examiner and Assistant General Counsel for the Texas Education Agency until 1987. Since leaving TEA, Ms. Buechler has practiced exclusively in the area of school law. Her focus is in the area of special education law and she is board certified in administrative law. Ms. Buechler is a frequent speaker at in-service programs and law seminars and is also the director of the National Educators Law Institute.
